## Motajica, 2018

Motajica is a new location which we choose for the research according to the recent received information from hunters about wolves' attacks at livestock in the north part of this area. Although, according literature, wolves don't inhabit Motajica and the mentioned attacks were probably performed by jackals which are very usual in this territory, hunters were absolutely definite that wolves performed mentioned attacks. As it is known from the past, Motajica can be inhabited with animals even from Croatia, where Sava River is not barrier, so it can be possible that wolves came, not just from other parts of the Bosnia and Herzegovina, but even from Croatia, in searching for the pray. We have, so far, set photo traps at several sites within Motajica locality, which present regularly animals transect zones.
