

## ERRATA

The side-necked turtles described in the paper “Hatchling morphology of the Amazonian toad-headed turtle (*Mesoclemmys raniceps* [Gray 1855]) from Peruvian Tropical Andes (Testudines: Chelidae)” were erroneously identified as *Mesoclemmys raniceps*. In fact, they belong to the *Mesoclemmys gibba* species. The error was pointed out by the author Flavio Molina, from Museu de Zoologia da Universidade de São Paulo (São Paulo, Brazil), based on the analysis of hatchlings, young and adults of *M. raniceps* and *M. gibba* from Brazil and Peru. The authors apologize for their mistake but point out that the morphological description presented is still valid and is the most complete for hatchlings *M. gibba* from Peru.
